

REMARKS

1. Presentation of the already achieved results/outcomes/targets from WP1, WP2, and WP3:
 - The coordinator has presented the achieved results and deliverable from WP1 (1.1. Analysis of policies, practices, and legal frameworks of PT and SCHE in European countries).
 - Colleagues from UES and UNSA presented that their research on the need of PT and SCHE in BiH (2.1. Report with survey results) and existing learning methodologies (3.2 Report on the existing eLearning methodologies and technologies) are on going, but that the most of the questionnaires are filled and that they will prepare first draft for the SC meeting in Bled in the second half of September 2021.
 - Nenad Marković presented preliminary data on the need on PT and SC programs, where the most important data came from the business sector and ministries.
 - Dženana Husremović presented UNSA research related to universities and students on e-learning methodologies and potential of SC and PT programs.
2. Travel issues and staff cost – budget
 - The coordinator expressed a great level of hope that future travels would be able to accomplish, due to the fact that pandemic is still ongoing.
 - The coordinator explained the importance for each of partners to be present at each project meeting, especially during WP2 which is related to regulative on PT and SCHE in BiH.
 - Partner universities are asked to finish the public procurement procedure for the equipment, since the largest part of their first tranche is related to equipment cost.
3. Equipment purchase - analysis
 - University of Mostar and University of Tuzla are this WP leaders. Purchase of equipment must be realized by June 14th 2022 and preparations will start as soon as possible. The purchase procedure will be made as joint one, for all 5 universities from BiH.
 - UES, as a partner responsible for joint public procurement, noticed that the declaration at the UNZE, and that they would send it to UNMO for the final signature, after the procedure at UNZE is finished. After that, the public procurement will start.
